So.... technically....She cannot call Primary over yet.

She says for nearly all of the Weather-Station-Sites it was technically an Infection... roughly 12 Hrs @ 67°F = Moderate Infection.

She also mentioned that in your Blocks that were squeaky-clean in 2016, you may not of had any Spores left to discharge.

If you have been stayn covered, and had no Scab last year, you may want to stay with your current strategy and not worry about getting something out there within 24 Hrs-Etc....???

Your Call ... Tough Call.

If you feel some of your Coverage has been a bit sketchy in those windy conditions, you might want to get a Center on.

If you're on a Protectant Schedule doin Centers Mondays and Thursdays you should be sittn pretty.

Amy will be monitoring those Rods til she gets 2 Rains with zero [0] Spores.

Also ...Remember about Not-Spraying in the extreme heat... One Guy told me he starts at around 11.30 pm....and quits before 10.30 am. Thats as good as you can get it.
