## Fruit Ridge Notes - Saturday - June 3 – 2017

**Greetings to All** from a Very Cloudy-Rainy-Lookin-Fruit Ridge Ave....Sure Hope We are in for some Rain !!!!!!!  
Its 10.30am here right now and the Radar looks very Promising !!!

### \*\*\*\*Apples

~Guys are getting the Abamectin 0.15EC on ...They're gonna end up with 2 complete Applns of 20 oz-Ac....Total of 40 oz-Legal-Seasonal-Limit.

~Remember wherever you see any WAA [Woolies] you should use the Imidacloprid4SC [**Alias4F**] at the 3.2 oz-Ac.Rate...at least 2 Applns for stopping Woolies. Remember that Alias is only costing you apprx \$2 at that full-recommended rate of 3.2oz...and you are allowed 16 oz-Season. That's 5 Apps of 3.2 oz. I highly recommend using the the Limit....for like \$10-\$11 per year. It also get Leaf-Hoppers - All other Aphids - Tentiform Leaf Miner - and helps against Maggot and S.JoseScale a quite a little bit....???

### \*\*\*\*All Fruit Crops

~Where you have Blocks that the SanJoseScale has been getting a come-back-foot-hold... Consider adding the 1lb-Ac. Diazinon50W. But First-- Check the List that your Fave Processor gives some of you as to **"Can-Do-Cannot-Do" Restrictions**....???. Someone said a certain Processor doesn't like Diazinon....???

I really like it because of efficacy and cost-per-acre efficiencies.... Use 1 lb..... for like \$8??

You can only use 2 - 1 lb.ac.Applns in Apples.... Diazinon takes care of quite a list of other Pest-Targets.

**Do Not** mix with Captan....and be very mindful of whatever else you Tank-Mix with....Some guys think Diazinon causes some Russet...?? Alicandro says it's when we put Captan with it that he see's issues.... Please dont put it in with some LowGradeLiquidFertilizer from down the street....pretty please.

Diazinon is also Labeled for and will help in Control of Blueberry Pests Cranberry FruitWorm, Cherry FruitWorm, Blueberry Maggot, Thrips, TwoSpottedSpider Mites, and in most All Stone FruitCrops, Pests such as MealyBugs, all the different Scales...like 5 or 6 Scales, Aphids...adults and eggs, MiteEggs, several different Borers....In Pears & Apples Labeled for CodlingMoth + AppleMaggot.... ....For my money....I just know that for \$8 I would be seriously looking for where Diaz has a fit....
