Yup---Lookn on Pg.116 in E-154 You'll see that the **Warrior-Imidacloprid-Combo [Like \$4]** is really rated really high on BMSB, All of the Leaf-Rollers, GreenFruitWorm, STLM, TarnishedPlantBug, Green Aphids, RoseyAphid, WALH, **And** Rated "**G**" on AppleMaggot, CodlingMoth, Oriental FruitMoth, PlumCurculio, and "**G**" also on Woolies. Make sure to use the Max-Rate-Acre of Each....

3.2 oz Imidacloprid 4F [ProVoke] Not RUP

5.12 oz LambdaCy 1EC[Warrior] **RUP** and Remember....**Get 130% Coverage**.....Slow Down.
