...Use it up.....Get it Gone... It'll soon be Ill-Legal.

On Apple=14 Da.P.H.I.---12 Hr.REI. Page 116 also says it's real **Safe** on all of the Good Guys.....

*****Q & AYes ...Prevam can be Tank-Mixed** with just about everything. And.... It has really really serious "Surfactant-Qualities" It will indeed satisfy any+all of your "**Spreader-Penetrater**" needs in this Tank-Mix.

I like to be careful with Prevam, as it actually "Heats-Up" my Tank-Mix a little But we have had a bunch of Guys using in a bunch of different Tank-Mix-Scenarios.... No Problem.

The most common Use-Rate of Prevam is 4 Pints in a 100 ga. of Tank-Mix which is a 0.5%vv The higher-side of the Use-Rate is "0.8% Solution-by-Volume" == which is 100 oz in 100 Gal.

If you use the 4 pint-100g, and you Spray 33 GWA, your Prevam is costing you only about \$10 per-acre. When I look at how this stuff kills *Eggs - *Nymphs - *Larvae - *Winged Adults and *Worms.... I realize the **\$10** is a Good Deal.

A bunch of Grape Growers really like the ORO-Agri Products... and the Organic Production Folks love it.
