******So....What Pesticides Can Freeze....???**

Thankfully...Every Fall this question comes up....Meaning a bunch of Ya'll are watching closely how to care for Your Inventory of Pesticides, *Keeping them Viable for 2018 Use.*

Ideally, Keeping all Pesticides between 48°F and 68°F is where you wanna be. That's what we do here....keeping the doors closed when it is really hot out...and of course having a really extra great Insulation Job in our Warehouses..... and then on the other end of it.... everything here is heated of course.

It's important to not let anything freeze. That means Wettable Powders and well as "D.F.s" and WDG's and Granules....Just don't let any costly Pesticides freeze. What's considerably worse, is a Pesticide being exposed to a "Freeze-Thaw-Freeze-Thaw" situation.... really ugly.

Yes, even Wettable Powders.... the quality of effectiveness is degraded under Freeze-Thaw conditions. I have seen proof of that.

If you get caught next Spring with products that froze, blend 1/3 of that with 2/3 of good fresh stuff to get to a comfort level of efficacy.

Letting Liquids freeze usually means some crystallization and tiny chunks that plug nozzles and screens--etc.
