******the 8oWDG** Captan is indeed my Fave Choice of all the Captan Formulations available. You're allowed 40-Lbs-per-Season-Acre so it's kinda hard to 'Run-Out-of-Legal-Pounds'.

Like If you miss-a-serious-boat early on...??? ...and then you end up doing the Secondary-Scab-Struggle, you would be doin the 5lb.Ac.Rate every 7 Days for 4 Apps....Which still leaves you 20 lbs to use in the earlier **CapToZeb**-Program-Apps.... at the 2Lb-Ac-Rate.

Captan8oWDG....24-Hr-REI...**Zero[-o-]Days P.H.I.....** No Limit on Number of Apps ... Use by Ground Appln or air.....Captan has been around a long long time. I was gonna say about 90 years...**but** ...I checked, and I found out it was first Registered in 1951...the year I was born ... So.... Really a very long long time ago.

******Expounding** on the Captan...**Reminds** me to also Repeat"**No-Oils**". We never recommend any Oils. They are the reason for a multitude of Damage and HeadAches of all sorts. No matter if you're goin really early on, or later on....there are *always* a pile of *warnings* surrounding the use of any Oils. Just don't. There's absolutely Zero Reason to ever use any Oils.

Cost...??? \$15-\$17 ...??? Not bad. But the more GWA you use the more Fung-Out I recommend. If I felt this stuff was outrageously priced, you would not see this mention....

Do not Tank-Mix with the "**005**".

I dont recommend a Tank-Mix with Regalia either. **Both Regalia and FungOut** have a very cool & strong attack-strategy of their own.... Lets just let them do it...individually.
