*****Apple Scab**...It's always smart to be extra cautious in those Hot-Spot-Blocks where we had Scab last Season.... as the Inoculum Level is so much higher there....

If you get Nervous-Scared-Behind...??? And you're runnin a CapToZeb-Program....?? Just get into your Tank-Mix with some Xtra Captan80WDG...like 5lb.-Ac...and Leave your EBDC at 3Lb-Ac. Also add 8oz-Ac.Rally40W. And...If you're doin the first 4-Alt-Center-Apps with 1 Qt.-Ac."005" and get scared, do the same thing....add 5Lb.80WDG and 8oz.Rally.

Most all Experts still feel we are gettn 24-Hour-"Reach-Back" with CapToZeb...and EBDCs...and Captans.....Always remember to do your Clock-Cipherin back to the beginning of the Wetting Event....as that is actually when the Infection starts.

*****Sulfur....with Captan** I remember when almost Nobody would ever put Sulfur with any Captans...because of some Phyto/Frog-Eye-type damage Issues...?? But in recent years I know of Guys that really do it quite a bit on purpose. And, I see Alicandro saying if you're out there spraying in a light-misting-rain, adding Sulfur to CapToZeb is good....for Mildew... but especially for RainFastNess.

*****Coda-Phone**Pretty sure.....I think Amy is still going to be doing the CodaPhone thing for us....??? 616.632.7868
