****If You are Going after a WoolieAphid problem, Diazinon [21 Da.PHI] may be your best bet. Do not Tank-Mix with any Captans. Diazinon is touchy for Fruit-Finish when Tank-Mixed with Captans. It plays nice in the Tank, but does something to the Finish. 4-Da.REI...Watch-Field-Posting requirements....

....and Remember...Gerbers doesn't like Diazinon.

Help us out....If you're only going after Woolies in a few Hot-Spots, Keep track of that Tank-Mix and take extra-special notice of any Fruit-Finish issues in the aftermath.... I'd like to know if you see any ugliness....??? ...and what else was in the Tank.

****Yup....Cormoran Insecticide From Adama--MANA.... I really like the Concept... Taking 2 well-performing-Products and building 1 "Broader" Spectrum Product We have Dozens... ...maybe Hundreds of Guys, regularly Tank-Mixing 2-3 Insecticides to cover all the Target-Pests. This has proven over-&-over to be very cost-effective and getting over 100% Control.... with no Tank-Mix-Issues.

This Cormoran is actually Rimon and Assail.... Its almost as much Rimon==9.1% vs. 9.3%...But its not even 1/4th the Assail... 7.3% instead of 30%. It costs about \$49-Ac for the Medium-24 oz-Ac-Rate. I would not use less than the 24 oz.Rate....which will not give you as much Rimon as you normally use...and only 2/3s the Assail you would normally use for C.Moth.

Your Cost-per-Acre for what you're actually getting isn't much different than Mixing your own at those same levels.

We're allowed 95 oz-Season-Apples..... 89 oz.Yr in Blues.

14 Da.P.H.I....12 Hr.REI. The Rate-Range is 20-28 oz.-Ac. Deanna has a source for this.

****Our Friend Jeff Alicandro Tells his Guys... "Do not use Amine-2,4-D in Orchards within 5 - 6 Weeks of Harvest." He has seen the Side-Effects.... premature-ripening of Fruit and early Fruit-Drop....and the 'InExplicable' loss of Fruit-Firmness in Storage.... And Jeff said to keep 2,4-D out of that Orchard if the Temps are 90* or higher..... because of Volatilization into that Tree Canopy.
