Fruit Ridge Notes - Row Crop-All Ya's - Friday - July 6 - 2018

**Hello from Kent City's Sunny West Side.... and Happy Friday !!
What a Beautiful Day !!!**

I'm Still Hearing a lot of Fire-Works goin off around 10pm at Home-Gooding St--Pretty Cool..... Lovin It.

I had a Call.... from a huge **Row-Crop Pal**....He's been using the Adjuvant-Penetrant **WetCit** from **ORO-Agri**....Tank-Mixin with his Glyphosate Applns.... He said its pretty Amazing...the Burdock and the MayorsTail ?? ...which almost nobody expects Glyphosate to control anymore these days...??? **WetCit** with 1 Qt.GN-Glyphosate Smoked it.

*****The QueenAnne Sweets ...and the Dark-Sweets** that are by our Patio and also interplanted in the 10-ac.-Trial-Block by our House....All Trees had a decent Crop, but now absolutely bare...Cleaned...as of June 30th. They were not even ready yet ...Not edible...Except for BlackBirds and Robins apparently. I could have saved them of course with the **AvianControl** Product...but did not want to bother my Cooperator with the extra hassle....for only 6-8-Trees.

*****Some Guys are Still Blazing** away with 5 lbs. Captan 80WDG every 7 Days.... The Secondary Scab is kinda bad in a few Blocks. Please dont get talked into those Scab-I-Cides that cost you 2X - 3X more....They are not gonna get the job any better.

*****Compared to Last Year....** It appears acupla of the Big-Hi-Dollar Newer Miticides have maybe adjusted their Per-Acre-Cost down a bit...??? But only a little bit...??

If you Maxed-Out your AgriMek-Abamectin and somehow still have a ERM-Build-Up...??? Please check with Dee 616.887.9933 on some of those costs....

++We carry a lot of those ...as Some Guys request them....

++If you Maxed-Out the A-Mek---2 Apps @ 20 oz.Each--and you still see ERM's, Then.....(a)You didnt use the InSpray-90 correctly with it.... and (b) You are the First One I have heard of where it has ERM-Break-Thru's.

++No...I am not very concerned about "Wearin-It-Out".... Isn't it about 60 years or more now that we've been using Abamectin....??? I actually think the Fed will take it away from us before we 'Wear-it-Out'....

*****Streptomycin...AgriMycin... We are gettn CloseTime** to be concerned about our P.H.I....On the Producing Blocks. 50 Da.PHI on Apples....30 Da.PHI on Pears. Whenever we have to much Wind and Rain ...like if we can see where some Leaves were blown-off the Trees, we need to be concerned bout Trauma.... So like on those Hi-Dollar-Non-Bearing-Systems....Keep on using 1 lb.Step with 1 Pint CS2005 whenever you suspect Trauma. If you're out of PHI time on Producing Blocks, Use 1 Pint CS2005. We have a whole bunch of Guys now that keep CS2005 in nearly every Tank....Because it is so strong on the 7-8-9 different Summer Diseases that MSU says we need to be watching closely. If I was one of you Guys, I guess I wouldn't get to concerned about a 'Trauma-Event'...??? You're already covered with the Systemnic-CS2005 Bactericide-Fungicide.... "005" is so Low-Cost...

*****Diazinon50W... Some Q&A...**

Some Vegies are Zero(0) DaysPHI, and some are 14 Days.

...21 DaysPHI for Apples +Cots +Prunes +Plums...

....and 7 DaysPHI for Blues ...

3 Days for most Melons...and yet Lettuce is 14 Da.....

At \$8-Lb....I love this stuff....Even tho Gerbers doesn't.

You'll notice some of those Veggie Guys can use 2-3 lbs-acre...?? Apples is just only **1 Lb.-Ac.**

This is a **RUP**...Watch your Label. That Label is Huge....Virtually all Crops and totaling maybe 100 Insects Controlled....Lots of various Rates and Do's and Do Nots.... Butt Kickn Product. The Label is the Law. R.U.P.....
