Fruit Ridge Notes - SWDs - Tarts - July 17 - 2018

Hello All.... Hoping the Harvest is Proceeding Smoothly

******MSU Folks Remind** us the Fave Host Plants for SWDs are *Blues *Raspberries *Cherries *Gooseberries *Currents and *Saskatoons.... and some 'Wild' Hosts are *Blackberries *Honeysuckle and *Buckhorn. So...Your Crop situated next to any of these is going to have higher SWD pressure.

~~**Tart** Cherry Guys...

Keep in mind the 24(c)Label on Mustang Maxx...with a 3 Da.P.H.I..... Way down from the 14 Da.PHI-Normal-Label....and only \$3.35-Ac. !!

Apparently that 24(c) is not available for on Sweets.... But They are mostly all done now anyway.

Experts say to do Full-Every-Row-Applns for SWD Control.... I concur.

MSU says you Tart Cherry Guys have no 1 Da.PHI choices like the Blues-Boys do....But you do have 4 - 3 Da.Products.... Danitol [E]-\$28 ... Exirel 10SC [E]-\$60 ... and Perm-Up/Pounce [F]-\$3.20 ...and now with the **24(c) Mustang Maxx.[E]-\$3.35**

Any Blocks where you have 7 Days yet, I'd be doin 2 lbs. Imidan, just to get an 'O.P.' into the mix.

Warrior [LambdaCy [E]has a 14 Da.PHI...but it's only about \$1 per-Acre. Entrust @ 6 oz-Ac. [E] has a 7 Da.PHI = \$75....for Guys needing OMRI Listed stuff.... also OMRI = **Grandevo**...Rated Good [G] ... **o Da.PHI** ... 3 Lbs.-Ac.-about \$45
