I haven't checked the Gauge yet ...

******Turkeys.... Yup... Naughty Bad Birds Really Naughty.**

We have indeed had Growers that have successfully repelled Turkeys from their Honey Crisp by using the **AvianControl** product. Pretty doggone low-cost too....

Just figure about a Qt-per-50 Ga.Water...and set the Nozzles more to the Lower-Limbs... You should maybe get 2 Ac-per-50Gal. Go Alternate-Centers.

******Yes We still have some Strathmore Aluminum Step Ladders** and PicknBuckets.

So the 1st thing we need to do is to get a look at your Inventory List.... What's on Your Shelf ...??

******Several Apple Guys are Making** sure to Have **CS2005** in their Pre-Harvest-Tank-Mix. It helps huge against some Molds and PinHead type Fungal Issues "Post-Harvest" in Storage and Handling ...and on Store Shelves. Really Cheap. Really Effective.

Just figure a 1-Pint-Acre-Rate.... If you're using upwards of 60-70 GWA, maybe try to get closer to 1 Qt.Ac.Rate.

It's been suggested to use 16 oz.Rate Pristine. Thats like \$45-Ac....and one of the Chemical-Components in the Pristine A.I. has some serious Resistance Issues....???

That **005**...???. The 24 oz.Rate = **\$10.30**and it's proven so much more effective.

******Orchards Situated next to SoyBean** Fields may have issues with BMSBs much longer into the Fall Season than other Blocks.....a little Agr.Tip from Alicandro.

******With All of the Hot-Dry-Abuse.... Guys battling Secondary Scab** ...for the most part ... did not need any of the Heavy-Duty-Ultra-Pricey-Fungicides.

The guys that just stuck to the 5Lb-Ac-Captan80WDG Program, all kept it off the Fruit just fine....Burned it out.... It's gone.
