Lots of 4F Choices...Lots of weird critically variable Labeling...

This also helps against SWDs *Waaay* more than Folks give it credit for....and Jap Beetle... and it Kills all Aphids.

Of course their "Fave" was certainly Not of the Premium-Quality-Inputs that InSpray-90 comes from.
