now... Too many Insects & Fungals & Bacterials that will not be 100%
Controlled that way...
You'll see the Biggest-Short-Fall in Control on the SummerDiseases,
Woolies, SJS, LeafRollers.... Mites.
**** This "Hot-Dry" Spell will make the Bitter-Pit Pressure more
intense... Keeping the Best-Top-Shelf Calciums in that Tank Every
Center....and when we look at the Hi-Cost of Bitter-Pit in our Honeys, we
do that other Center with a Calcium in the "Off-Week".... Our Honeys get
a Complete-Full-Cover-Calcium once a Week.
