These Two Good-Ol' OrganoPhosphateInsecticides are really very serious ButtKickrs.... and if you do use both at the Max-Seasonal-Legal-Rates you only spend about \$35-Acre-per-Season-Total. That \$35 is about \$125-per-Acre Less than what some Guys get talked into spending for SanJoseScale & RoseyAphid Controls. Seriously... I've seen the PaperWork. Thats a Fact.

Both of these Ol'War-Horse-O.P.s are Labeled for use in a huge-long-List of Crops.... I really really like these old Butt-Kickin Nukes.... I encourage everyone to use the Legally-Labeled-Limit of BothMax them Out every time we can, until the Fed takes them away from us.

Also... keep in mind that on the Label this product doesn't claim RoseyAppleAphid *Control*... Only "Suppression" but I think it does quite well on all Aphids...

And... pretty much kinda Safe to Bees.

==I'm thinkn some Blues Boys might want to look at this one for Gall Wasp....??? Because it doesnt hurt the Bees to bad...??? I'm still researching that angle.... but it certainly has some of the right attributes Only serious problem I have with Sivanto is that 14 oz-Rate is like \$37-Ac...?? Considerably higher than the Maxed-Out-Seasonal-Limit-Combined-Cost of the Lorsban [Chlorpyrifos] & Diazinon together.
